Innovative childcare facility to open in Cedar Park

CEDAR PARK – (*January 19, 2007*) – A new childcare facility has taken 3.11 acres on Parmer Lane just south of FM 1431 in Cedar Park, Texas. The Rainbow Station was represented by Dean Janeff and Sherry Naquin Sanchez, both retail specialists of NAI Commercial Industrial Properties Co.
